## Cleanest Ward Will Get Rs 20K As Prize Money

**Bangalore:** Sweep clean your ward and make it the best; bag a prize money of Rs 20,000 a month! Starting this month, BBMP hits on a monthly prize competition for better work on ground from its staff at zonal and ward levels.

There are various parameters on the monthly report card — from door-to-door collection of garbage to property tax, regular planting of saplings to development of lakes and parks across every ward area in each zone and even ensuring rain water harvesting (RWH) setups at all public places, open areas, parks and roadside drains — all these sectors will be judged by a committee of seven members. Even the number of TDRs distributed to properties identified for road widening and encroachments cleared on BBMP's storm water drains will matter. However, the tricky factor on the list is the weightage of 40% that has been given for segregation of garbage in households! Simply put, to bag the first prize, officials must ensure they have the residents' co-operation in having separate bins with wet and dry wastes separated.

### ON THE REPORT CARD - PARAMETERS FOR APPRAISAL

- Solid waste segregation at household level: — 40%  
(Target: Total no of houses)
- Lake and park development: — 10 (Target: Fencing all lakes and planting at all parks)
- Planting saplings: —10%  
(Target: At rate of two saplings/house)
- RWH units at public places, parks, drains—10%

(Target: 100 units per sq km)

- Collection of property tax & other dues—20%  
(Target: From all properties identified on GIS map)
- TDRs for road widening—5%  
(Target: Distributing TDRs to all identified properties)
- Clearing encroachments on SWD—5%  
(Target: Number of identified encroachments cleared)
